Once the introduction is complete, you will be given an abbreviated tour of the police facility and if possible, the Virginia Beach 9-1-1 Emergency Communications & Citizen Services. - b. Fully and forever release and discharge the City of Virginia Beach, it's police officers, agents, and employees, from any and all claims, demands, damages, rights of actions, or causes of actions, present or future, whether the same be known, anticipated, or unanticipated, resulting from or arising out of my being in, on, or about any such Police Department vehicles, or at any or all of the premises or places aforesaid, or while accompanying any police officers of the City of Virginia Beach as aforesaid;
- c. Indemnify and hold harmless the City of Virginia Beach, its police officers, employees, and agents, for any acts or conduct on my part of whatever kind or nature whatsoever, while in, on, or about any such Police Department vehicles, or at any or all of the premises and places aforesaid, or while accompanying any such police officer as aforesaid;
- d. #### **Rules and Regulations for Ride-Along Participants**

As a Ride-Along observer, you are expected to follow the instructions listed below in order to safeguard yourself and minimize the possibility of interfering with normal police activities.

- 1. All Ride-Along observers shall sign a waiver of liability form.
- 2. Observers are required to be at the designated police precinct/bureau at their scheduled time.
- 3. All observers will be returned to the precinct/bureau at the completion of the Ride-Along assignment or at any time requested by the participant.
- 4. Tape recorders or cameras are not permitted unless prior approval has been obtained.
- 5. Participants shall not be permitted to carry a weapon while participating in the program.
- 6. It is desirable to ask questions regarding procedures and activities; however, it must be done at an appropriate time. Observers shall not interfere with the officer's activities or duties.
- 7. Observers shall not participate in any police activity unless specifically directed by the officer.
- 8. Observers shall not leave the patrol car any time without first obtaining permission from the officer.
- 9. Observers shall not converse with prisoners, suspects or witnesses, or other parties contacted on police business.
- 10. Upon signing the application, the observer will be automatically checked through the computer system ensuring no outstanding warrants exist. A records check will also be conducted.
- 11. All Ride-Along observers will be required to wear a department-issued observer identification name tag at all times during the tour.
- 12. Remember, a Ride-Along participant rides in the capacity of an observer only and is under complete control of the officer at all times. Failure to follow these rules and/or the instructions of the officer will result in the immediate termination of the tour.

#### **Host Officer Checklist and Guide**

**Purpose:** To provide guidance to Officers selected to serve as Host Officers.

Due to a change in policy, it is now possible for all Patrol Officers, not on probation, to be selected by their Supervisor to serve as a Host Officer. This guide is for your edification, thus ensuring that you will be an impressive representative for the Department and the City.

- First and foremost, make yourself familiar with General Order 11.12; it deals with the Ride-Along program and the responsibilities of the Host Officer.
- When assigned to, and upon first meeting a Ride-Along participant, please be courteous and friendly.
   Ask the participant what they hope to observe or learn during this period, and attempt to match your activities to meet that goal. During muster, introduce him/her to the squad. This will go far in establishing trust and mutual respect between the citizen and you, the officer.
- All participants will wear a Precinct ID card while participating in the Ride-Along program. If an ID card is
  not in the Sergeant's office, then one can be obtained from the Precinct Desk Officer (PDO). Please
  ensure that the participant returns the ID card at the end of the shift.
- Ride-Along participants shall not carry weapons (except LEO), operate vehicles or use equipment such as the police radio except in the case of an emergency.
- Ride-Along participants shall not carry any cameras or recording equipment unless the Precinct Commander gives prior approval.
- Remember, the <u>Host Officer</u> is responsible for the safety and welfare of the Ride-Along participant. Do not place, or allow them to become involved, in a dangerous or violent situation. Always be cognizant of your guest and where they are. You may drop off a participant in a suitable area, if you expect a volatile and dangerous situation to develop. It is permissible to allow the participant to go with you, out of the patrol car, on non-violent calls. However, remember you must secure the homeowner's permission before taking the participant onto private property.
- Ensure that your Ride-Along guest is dressed according to policy (provided on page 5 of this form) and presents a neat, clean appearance.
- As the Host Officer, you will be allowed to cover the entire area of the precinct.

Remember that the impression that you make on our guest will last forever, and the goodwill that you pass on to him/her will be relayed to their friends, neighbors and relatives.
